## **Briones Meeting Summary – Oct 8, 2008**

### **Round Table Pizza – Lafayette**

President Holland reported that the third leg of the Regional Tournament would be at SF Archers on October 12<sup>th</sup>. There will also be a work party on the 11th and a Club Shoot at the Briones Range on October 12<sup>th</sup>. The office of Vice President of the NFAA Region is open for interested Regional or club members who wish to serve the sport of Archery.

During the Treasurer's report, the Big Game Open results were discussed. Unfortunately only forty shooters participated in the tournament. Briones Archers had hoped for a larger turn out; but the shoot was held during deer season and that may have hurt our turnout. Ultimately, the club ended up losing a total of \$15.65 after all was accounted for.

The Secretary's minutes were submitted and approved. Also, since the November meeting was to include accepting any nominations for club officers, the Secretary was instructed to notify all club members as specified in the by-laws.

Mike Little reported on the website that he is updating <[www.brionesarchers.org](http://www.brionesarchers.org)>. We have had internet hits from all over the world. Many local people have also searched the website for information about the Briones Archers. Mike says he has prepared an electronic version of the newsletter available through the website as an alternative to having it mailed. Also, he asked the members if there was sufficient interest in an Archery Bulletin Board. There was some but not overwhelming interest. The club members who have been on the new website were very enthusiastic about how much information about the club and its activities is available.

The Range Captain reported that a work party would be held at the range on the upcoming Saturday with a Club Shoot on Sunday. Other than the usual jobs that need doing for the targets, Container 2 needs to have the flaking paint brushed off with a wire brush or electric sander and needs to be repainted.

Under new business, President Holland and Park Liaison John Erickson reported that the negotiations for a new contract were proceeding with EBRPD management.

President Holland and John Erickson have analyzed

the contract and have uncovered several problems within it. They will get clarification from EBRPD on those issues and continue negotiations on December 12.

Club members were reminded that nominations for club officers would be taken at the next meeting. Members also discussed getting a new supply of club jackets or T-shirts. There is strong interest in this topic. Jill Langston was drafted as the chair of the committee for a better logo for club T-shirts and jackets. It was also reported that President Holland would be seen as a Ninja Archer on "Mythbusters" on the Discovery Channel on October 15<sup>th</sup> at 9:00 eastern time.

## **Briones Archery Club Meeting Summary – Nov 5, 2008 Round Table Pizza – Lafayette**

President Holland reported that the Club had done very well at the third leg of the Regional Tournament at SF Archers on October 12<sup>th</sup>. Many of the club shooters won ribbons and belt buckles. Upcoming shoots that we should attend are the Redwood Bowmen Turkey Shoot on Nov. 23<sup>rd</sup> and the Northwoods Toys for Tots on Nov. 30<sup>th</sup>. President Holland also called an Executive Board meeting for Sunday, Nov. 16<sup>th</sup> at Frank Tinley's house. The budget for 2009 will be discussed along with selecting new 3-D animals that are needed.

As was reported via email to members, the Club's lock on the main gate by the parking lot has been lost; and the park locked the gate with a park lock. Thus, there is no way to unlock this gate for members to drive in. A lock has been given to the park and the park is expected to put it in operation sometime before the weekend. Unfortunately, the door to the scoreboard building that will complete enclosing the scoreboard porch for a storage area has not yet been completed. This project needs to be finished before the winter weather damages the unfinished project causing new problems.

There will be a club work party on Saturday, Nov. 8<sup>th</sup> and a club shoot on Nov. 9<sup>th</sup>. There are many small items that need to be done at the range to prepare for the upcoming winter. Also, the 3-D animals need to be inventoried for possible new purchases, and then the animals and the antlers, horns, pieces, etc. need to be put in the proper storage spots. The tarps on shelters over the shooting lane in the practice range need to be taken down and stored to prevent further damage to them.

Negotiations are still underway for a revised contract between the club and the Park. Increased liability insurance requirements are one of the problems being discussed. The club is having a lot of random foot traffic in parts of the range and trespassing through the shooting lanes. Members discussed the need for new fencing and for more visible signs to prevent accidents involving hikers or mountain bikers on the range.

Regional President Kathy Budding attended the meeting and encouraged all the members present to attend and participate in the NCFAA Regional meetings. According to President Budding the sport of Archery needs more participation in the management of the Region for the sport to be carried into the future. The Region's Secretary/Treasurer, Pete Budding also attended and had several suggestions to help the club with its day-to-day operations.

Also under New Business, it was reported that notice for officer nominations had been distributed to members as specified in the by-laws. No nominating ballots were received prior to the meeting. It was determined that the current officers were volunteering for re-election. It was moved and seconded that the current officers be elected by unanimous ballot. The motion was passed unanimously.
